# Museum of Vision

## Remembering Our Heroes

One of the saddest commentaries about the 20<sup>th</sup> Century is that it was riddled with wars, incursions, conflicts and occupations. Medicine was shaped during these events as were countless ophthalmologists who served in the American armed forces. Over the past few years the Museum of Vision has been exploring the history of ophthalmology during war time, creating a moving archive of stories, photos and personal memorabilia. One of those stories belongs to Dr. W. Dale Anderson who donated his photos and memories of his service in Vietnam.

Dr. Anderson arrived in Vietnam in August 1969. He was a Major and despite the fact that he had only just earned his Board certification he was considered the senior ophthalmologist in country. Dr. Anderson was made the "Consultant to the Surgeon" for the entire U.S. force and required to travel to other area hospitals to train doctors, who were not ophthalmologists, on how to perform ophthalmic surgery.

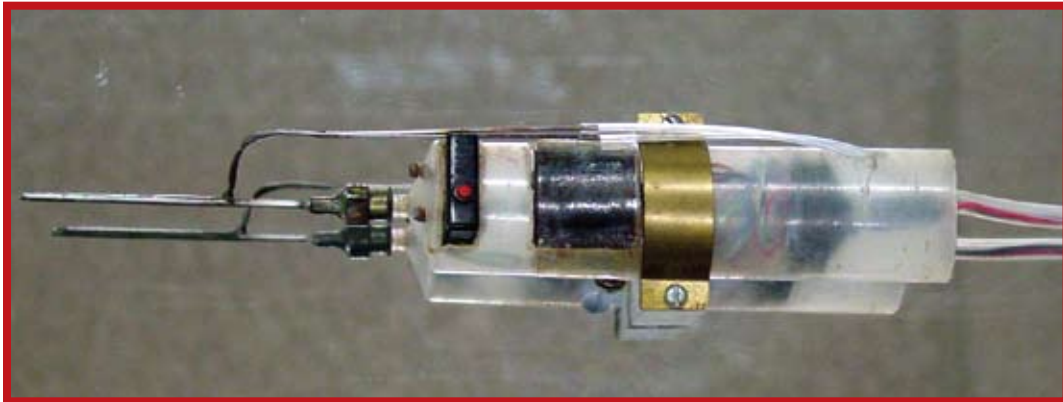
Dr. Anderson describes Vietnam as a "helicopter war" which meant that "there were no front lines or rear areas." Hospitals were near the fighting and occasionally under fire themselves. Medical care was given not only to American soldiers but to prisoners of war and civilians. Equipment was "primitive" and Dr. Anderson describes in detail how diagnostics and surgery were performed. His photos of patients and surroundings are extraor-

dinary and were used by Dr. Francis LaPiana, an author of several works on military medicine and its history.

The Museum of Vision strives to collect the history of ophthalmology, from its roots in ancient medicine to modern innovations. Military ophthalmology has its place in this history and we are proud to remember our heroes.

### Ophthalmic Heritage

Ophthalmology and the Academy have played important roles in the history of medicine. The Foundation's Museum of Vision preserves this history and translates it into an educational resource for ophthalmologists and the public. Last year, the museum reached more than 350,000 people through its activities.

### Services

The Museum of Vision provides Academy members and the general public with educational resources and services. The museum introduced over 200,000 people to the world of vision through its curriculum guides. It



also helped nearly 100 people with requests for historical research and photos.

### Exhibits

Over 145,000 people toured the museum's exhibits or saw museum objects on loan this year. Exhibit venues included the Annual Meetings of the West Virginia Academy of Ophthalmology and the American Society of Retina Specialists as well as the Historic Arkansas Museum of Little Rock.

## SENIOR SAVES VISION THROUGH EYECARE AMERICA PROGRAM

Sarah Polsfuss stuffed her notes and the article about EyeCare America into a drawer, where it stayed for over a year. But then one day, her eyesight failed her to the point she'd had enough.

She was frustrated with not being able to see well enough to read, take her daily walks or gauge how much salt and pepper she was pouring into her cooking. She dug out the story about the organization and called. Today, she has better vision than she thinks she's ever had. "I thought it sounded too good to be true," Polsfuss said. That's why she didn't act when she first read about EyeCare America and their services for senior citizens.

Polsfuss, 67, was diagnosed with cataracts in both eyes 13 years ago. She didn't have the money or insurance for the surgery she needed and eventually went blind in her right eye. "I was young to be having cataracts, but the doctor told me that many people in Alabama have cataracts caused by the sun," she said.

She said she doesn't like to ask for help, but this time she knew it was worth ask-

ing. Within a couple of weeks of her phone call, she found out she qualified and the paperwork was done. EyeCare America referred her to a local volunteer ophthalmologist. During November of last year, she had surgery to remove her cataracts, saving her from complete blindness, all without having to pay any out of pocket costs. In all, she had one year of free medical eye care, except what little Medicare she had that was used toward her medical bills. "My surgery was longer than other people's, because the cataract had been in there so long and it was so thick," she said.

Polsfuss recently went back for a six-month checkup and the doctor said everything looked good.

"I can see so good now that I have to pinch myself to know it's true. I wish my family had warned me about all my wrinkles though," she said with a laugh. Polsfuss has resumed her passions of reading books and taking long walks close to her apartment. Today, she only wears prescription glasses, and says she can see without them. She says it's a lot better than using every magnifying glass imaginable.

### EyeCare America

EyeCare America provides access to eye care for the medically underserved and for those at increased risk for eye disease through its corps of 7,000 volunteer ophthalmologists dedicated to serving their communities. More than 90 percent of the care made available through EyeCare America is provided at no out-of-pocket cost to the patients. Since its founding in 1985, EyeCare America has become one of the largest programs of its kind in American medicine. Last year, EyeCare America helped 141,422 people.

### Seniors EyeCare Program

Offer free educational materials on eye health and provides seniors with ophthalmic care at no out-of-pocket cost for up to one year.

### Glaucoma EyeCare Program

Encourages early detection and treatment of glaucoma by promoting awareness of glaucoma risk factors and providing glaucoma eye exams to qualified individuals who are at increased risk.



### Diabetes EyeCare Program

Provides free educational materials that increase awareness of the importance of dilated eye examinations for individuals with diabetes and provides eye care to individuals 65 and older at no out-of-pocket cost.

### Children's EyeCare Program

Educates parents and primary care physicians about children's eye health and the importance of early childhood eye screenings and treatment.

### AMD EyeCare Program

The AMD EyeCare Program is designed to increase awareness about AMD risk factors and promote the importance of early diagnosis and treatment. EyeCare America provides free educational materials about AMD and available treatment options, as well as informs those diagnosed with AMD about vision rehabilitation resources that can improve or maintain their quality of life.

The EyeCare America web site features easy to use functions such as vision simulators, that allow users to see how vision would be affected from common eye diseases such as cataracts and glaucoma. Informative videos, created by the American Academy of Ophthalmology, are an added feature on the site and will provide visitors with a complete interactive experience.
